## Question:

I want to ask you about your comments on p.5 about the increase in wage costs in the sector in the period 1996-2003. You say that wage costs increased by 28%, and that this figure is "broadly comparable with the growth in the SNA" [safety net adjustment].

What was the growth in the SNA in that period?

## Answer:

Safety Net Adjustments

The Department of Finance and Administration has advised that the Safety Net Adjustments between 1996 and 2003 increased the Federal Minimum Wage by around 28.3%, from \$349.40 to \$448.40.
