How does MUP compare (with Bond and Notre Dame)?

How many academic staff do Bond and Notre Dame have? And MUP?

The MUP Annual Report lists 14 academic staff. Then there are the 39 "Fellows".

## Answer:

Melbourne University Private statistics

a) Data for student enrolments for Bond University and the University of Notre Dame Australia are provided below. The Department does not collect statistics from Melbourne University Private (MUP). It is not required to submit this information as it does not receive any Commonwealth support. The Senator would need to refer the question about current enrolments at MUP to the university.
