## Question:

- a) What is the value of FEE-HELP debt incurred by students at:
  - i. Table B providers
  - ii. Non Table A and B providers

at the first census date for 2005?

b) What projections are available for each year from 2005 to 2009?

## Answer:

FEE-HELP debt in 2005 and projections for 2005 to 2009

- a) The Department does not yet have data on FEE-HELP debts for 2005. This data will not be available until after 31 August 2005, which is the final date for providers to submit data for the first half of the year.
- b) The Department does not disaggregate estimated FEE-HELP debts for students at Table B providers from FEE-HELP debts at other private providers. The following table provides the Department's estimated total FEE-HELP debt for students at private higher education providers, including Table B providers, for each calendar year from 2005 to 2009. The estimates will be revised in the light of experience.
