## Question:

- a) How many staff work in the DEST Workplace Productivity Unit?
- b) What are their qualifications in the field of higher education?
- c) What are their performance objectives?
- d) What are the accountability mechanisms for their decisions?
- e) What appeal or review processes are in place relating to their decisions?

## Answer:

Workplace Productivity Unit, Department of Education, Science and Training

- a) Three people work in the Workplace Productivity Unit, which is a sub-unit of the Collaboration and Workplace Productivity Unit, Department of Education, Science and Training.
- b) All have higher education qualifications at degree level.
- c) The performance objectives of the unit are to develop policy, administer programmes and to advise the Minister for Education, Science and Training on workplace relations matters in higher education.
- d) & e) The Minister for Education, Science and Training will make decisions relating to whether universities meet the Higher Education Workplace Relations Requirements under s. 33-15 of the *Higher Education Support Act 2003*. The Minister's decisions may be challenged under the *Administrative Decisions* (Judicial Review) Act 1997.
