Question:

Senator Wong asked at *Hansard* page 9:

Are the numbers of people who are above the two-point increase on the current JSCI score available?

Answer:

Yes. Based on the 2004 (calendar year) inflow of job seekers who had a JSCI score and a Vocational Profile completed and weren't re-registrants, there were around 42,600 job seekers who had a JSCI score of 25 points or more (which is a two-point increase on the current threshold of 23 points).
