Senator Crossin provided in writing:

There is a new funding model for CDEP involving management fees and activity fees. Are these replacing the former Oncost grants? How will these be negotiated with CDEP organisations? Will there be a formula of so much per participant? Or will they be allocated on some sort of perceived “need”?

Answer:

Management fees and activity fees replace on-costs funding. Management and activity fees are negotiated with each individual CDEP organisation. The management fee will be on a fee for service basis and the activity fee varies according to the number of places in community activities.
