How long do these jobs have to last to attract payment for the IECs and what are they paid for their services?

Answer:

Indigenous Employment Centres may claim a Placement Fee when a participant is placed into eligible employment, and an Interim Outcome and Final Outcome payment for employment that is sustained for 13 and 26 weeks respectively.

The 2004-05 payment schedule for Indigenous Employment Centres is as follows:

Job Search Support Account	\$600
Training Account	\$880
Placement fee	\$550
Interim outcome fee	\$1,650
Final outcome fee	\$825
