Senator Carr provided in writing.

Question:

- 1. Does DEST have policy responsibility for early childhood education?
- 2. Is this shared with FACSIA? If so, what is the division of responsibility between the agencies?
- 3. Is there any Interdepartmental Committees of which DEST is a member whose terms of reference include early childhood education or preschool? If so, what are those terms of reference, what is the membership of the committee, and on what dates has the committee met in the last 12 months?

Answer:

Early Childhood Education

- 1 & 2. The Department of Families, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs (FaCSIA) has primary policy responsibility for early childhood, including child care and other financial support such as family tax benefit and programmes to support families with children.
 - Delivery of preschool education is the responsibility of state and territory governments. The Department of Education, Science and Training (DEST) provides policy advice on early childhood education to the Australian Government. DEST also supports the delivery of preschool education by funding preschool initiatives and providing per capita supplementary funding to support the participation of Indigenous children in preschool education. In 2006, this funding provided under the *Indigenous Education Targeted Assistance Act* was \$12.3 million. This includes \$5 million to broaden the Parent School Partnership Initiatives Programme to include a specific early childhood focus.
- DEST was a member of the Human Capital Interdepartmental Committee chaired by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet. This committee's work included consideration of early childhood education and preschool issues. The membership list and meeting dates for the Human Capital Interdepartmental Committee are attached.
