Senator Fisher asked on 3 June 2008, EEWL Hansard page 52:

Question

How soon do their AWAs expire? [in relation to those on AWA, where there was no collective agreement)

How many employees with AWAs might have them expiring on 30 June—a cluster, a hundred, a couple of hundred?

Answer

The Workplace Authority has provided the following response:

There are a variety of AWAs in place within the Workplace Authority. They have varying nominal expiry dates – see table below.

OEA 2006 – 2009	36 months from lodgement date
OEA 2007 – 2010	36 months from lodgement date
WPA – 240907 version	1 October 2010

WPA – Former OEA staff (14 Nov 07 version)	31 December 2009

There are approximately 88 employees covered by AWAs that nominally expired on 30 June 2008.
