**Question**

*Jobs Compact Key Performance Indicators.*

What are the key performance indicators to measure the elements of the Jobs Compact?

**Answer**

The Government will provide \$3.9 million over two years to monitor and evaluate major elements of the Jobs and Training Compact.

The Jobs and Training Compact includes 12 distinct initiatives. Depending on the initiative, key performance indicators may include the number of commencements and completions in employment programs and training courses, and employment outcomes.

This evaluation will include an assessment of the impact on employment of the Local Jobs and Get Communities Working elements of the Jobs Fund. It will also assess the effectiveness of the Local Employment Coordinators, Connecting People with Job Services, and Early Access to Employment Services for Redundant Workers initiatives.
