Question

What is the number of job seekers in each stage of the Job Network continuum, including the numbers classified as highly disadvantaged?

Answer

The following table shows the total numbers of job seekers on the Job Network active caseload, by placement type, and also the subset of numbers of those job seekers classified as highly disadvantaged by placement type. These figures are as at 26 June 2009.
