FAIR WORK EDUCATION INFORMATION

Senator ABETZ—Were there any hiccups or speed humps or whatever you might call it with particular organisations in them being able to deliver that which they had been contracted to deliver? Mr Kovacic—No. Indeed, the providers delivered over 3½ thousand activities, of which 2,400 were workshops or seminars. Senator ABETZ—How many people do we believe were reached? Mr Kovacic—I would have to take that on notice.

Answer

Over 53,800 people participated in activities under the Fair Work Education and Information program. In addition, there were over 100,000 visits to the two major web based sources of information for the program provided by the Council of Small Business of Australia and Australian Human Resources Institute.
