Question

COMPUTERS IN SCHOOLS - ELECTORATE OF CANNING

Senator CORMANN—I have a specific question in relation to the federal electorate of Canning, where 4,314 laptops were promised but only 882 have been delivered effective 21 April. Could I have a breakdown of those 882 that have been delivered by school?

Dr Arthur—We can provide that information. We are not going to have that information available today.

Senator CORMANN—I did not expect you to be able to do that. Senator CORMANN—Yes. I am listening to what you have just said, and I am looking at your answer and it says, 'Number of units required to reach the one-to-one benchmark,' and it gives the number 4,314. It then says 'Number of units actually installed', and it is 882. The question was: which schools have those 882 gone to? Dr Arthur—We can provide that information.
