# Harmonisation of Occupational Health and Safety laws

Does the Government have any modelling on the impact of harmonised Occupational Health and Safety laws? a. If so, can the modelling be provided to the Committee? b. If not, why not?

### Answer

Safe Work Australia has provided the following response:

As part of developing the model Work Health and Safety laws, Safe Work Australia is required to assess the impact of the laws through a Regulation Impact Statement (RIS).
