#### **Employment Pathway Fund Expenditure**

Senator ABETZ: If you can provide that to me on notice. What is the total expenditure to date on the Employment Pathway Fund for this financial year? Ms Parker: We can get it for the financial year. All our figures today are for the lengths of the contracts. Senator ABETZ: You can provide us the figures for the financial year and then provide us with a comparison for the last financial year. ... Ms Paul: While my colleagues are looking for that, when we give to you on notice the expenditure on EPF over the life of the contract, year-on-year, what you will see is a ramping-up. The reason is that the Employment Pathway Fund was new. Senator ABETZ: If you can provide that to me on notice. What is the total expenditure to date on the Employment Pathway Fund for this financial year?
