EFTSLOver The Last Decade

Senator MASON:Could we just have a look at the growth in undergraduate student numbers in Commonwealth supported places in public universities? ... I want an EFTSL—that is, an effective full-time student load basis. Is that the right figure? Ms Paul: Yes.

Senator MASON: Over the last decade. Again, you may have to take this on notice, Ms Paul, but in terms of EFTSL over the last decade, do you have raw numbers for the growth in undergraduate student numbers in Commonwealth supported places in public universities?
