## **Complaints About ACCESS Ministries**

Senator HANSON-YOUNG: Until the minister made that announcement that there would be an investigation, had the issue of complaints being raised about ACCESS ministries come across your desk previously? Mr Sheedy: Not in this form. Certainly we had had no complaints about proselytisation about ACCESS ministries. I am not in a position to tell you whether or not there had been any previous complaints. I imagine there would have been some, but maybe of an administrative nature. I can take that on notice. There definitely had been, at the time this arose, no complaints received by us about proselytising by ACCESS ministries.

## Answer

There has been one previous concern about proselytisation by an ACCESS Ministries chaplain that was raised in 2009 in the context of an annual Progress Report from a school rather than as a complaint direct to the Department. This was investigated and concluded at school level and related to a concern by a school council over the role of their chaplain. The concern was resolved by the school.
