Ms Jackson filed her proceedings in the Federal Court

Senator ABETZ: Is anybody able to tell us or remind us when Ms Jackson filed her proceedings in the Federal Court on this matter? Mr Kovacic: The date I have is on 23 April there was an urgent directions hearing in the Federal Court in relation to Ms Jackson's claim that 17 members of the HSU East branch are not entitled to vote at a meeting of union council. I am not sure if that coincides with the date of the application itself, but we can take that on notice. Certainly, there was a directions hearing in the Federal Court on the 23rd. Senator ABETZ: It stands to reason that it would have been filed beforehand and the parties given notice for this directions hearing. Ms Paul: We will get the date for you.

Answer

The originating application in the matter of *Katherine Jackson v Peter Mylan & Ors* was filed in the New South Wales Registry of the Federal Court on 20 April 2012.
