Question

Settlement

"Senator ABETZ: That stands to reason as most of these things are confidential. So I accept that. We now have a rare occasion-on page 16 of the Hansard chamber green, Mr Thomson acknowledges that he should not have used the word 'settlement' in relation to those defamation proceedings and that, rather, 'an agreement' would have been better. The suggestion that an offer had been made-did that suggest to you that there may have been a payment involved to Mr Thomson? Ms O'Neill: The relevant person's mind, in terms of the question you asked, would have to be the delegate's and only the delegate's. I can take the question on notice and attempt to get an answer to it."

Answer

Fair Work Australia has provided the following response.

As stated by Ms O'Neill on page 24 of Hansard, the relevant person's view concerning whether the use of the term "settlement" suggested that a payment may have been made by Fairfax to Mr Thomson was that of the Delegate, Mr Nassios. Due to the absence of Mr Nassios on approved leave, Fair Work Australia is not able to state whether Mr Nassios formed such a view.
