### FWA - Were complaints received about FWA Vice-President

Senator XENOPHON: I only have a short line of questioning for President Ross about his opening statement and matters relating to the HSU investigation. Can I just thank you, firstly, for your opening statement. I agree with you on the structural problems, and hopefully they will be rectified. Has Fair Work Australia received any complaints about Vice-President Michael Lawler in relation to the HSU investigation? Professor Ross: In my term as president, I have not received any complaints of that nature. Senator XENOPHON: Are you aware of any complaints prior to your term? Professor Ross: I am aware of Mr Thomson's statement and what he says about that, and what I have read in the media—but, beyond that, no. I assume, if there were any such complaints, they would have been addressed by my predecessor. Senator XENOPHON: Right. Could you take that on notice?
