### Percentages difference in each stream of JSA

Senator CASH: How have percentages in each stream changed since the start of the contract? For example, are there more in stream 1 job seekers now than there were previously? Are there fewer? Ms Drayton: I would have to take that on notice, I would think, unless there is somebody here who has that. Senator, I am sorry we will have to take that on notice.

#### **Answer**

The following table shows a series of regular snapshots of the Job Services Australia (JSA) caseload.

It should be noted that the percentages of job seekers in each stream for the 31 July 2009 figures will be affected by the staggered transition at the start of JSA. The subsequent figures for 31 March 2010, 31 March 2011 and 31 March 2012 shows that the distribution across the streams has generally stabilized.
