Question:

Can you provide us, as soon as possible, with the arrangements for the calculations and the payment of the Indigenous Support Fund and what they will mean for each and every institution around the country?

Answer:

Indigenous Support Funding (ISF)

The annual allocation of ISF is approximately \$25 million with the allocation indexed each year with the higher education cost adjustment factor. ISF will be increased by \$10.4 million over 3 years from 2005.

With the exception of Batchelor Institute of Indigenous Tertiary Education (BITE), payments of ISF are made to institutions through a performance-based formula. BIITE receives a block ISF grant, based on a higher per capita rate in consideration of the particular circumstances of BIITE students.

Arrangements for the calculation and payment of ISF provide for the amount to be received by BIITE being identified, and the funding to be received by each eligible provider is then calculated using the performance-based formula agreed with the sector. Core components of the formula are:

- 50 per cent of available funding is divided among institutions according to institutions' share of Indigenous student load i.e. Equivalent Full-time Students Units (EFTSU);
- 35 per cent of available funding is divided among institutions based on Indigenous student progress rate at the institution in the previous year weighted by Indigenous load; and
- 15 per cent of available funding is divided among institutions according to the actual number of award courses completed by Indigenous students in the previous year at the institution.

The actual amounts to be received by each institution in 2004 are at **Attachment A.**
