CSIRO has provided the following response.

Discovery Centre

a) The budget for the Discovery Centre has remained relatively stable in recent years. The CSIRO appropriation contribution for the Discovery Centre was increased from \$0.3m per annum to \$0.6m per annum in August 2002. Below is a summary of the total expenditure for the centre, including CSIRO's appropriation contribution.

2001-02 Actual	\$1.164m	\$0.3m
2002-03 Actual	\$1.164m	\$0.6m
2003-04 Budget	\$1.089m	\$0.6m
