Senator Webber asked at *Hansard* page 89:

Have there been any sanctions against any organisation for attempting to lodge an inappropriate vacancy?

Answer:

Vacancies that are notified directly by employers are screened for compliance with the site Conditions for Use. Where vacancies appear not to comply with the Australian JobSearch Conditions for Use, the employer is contacted, and in many cases the advertisement can be corrected cooperatively. However, if they are unwilling or unable to comply with the Conditions for Use, they are refused permission to advertise on the site. Sixty two organisations have been refused permission to advertise any vacancies on this site.
