Senator Marshall asked at *Hansard* page 111:

In relation to investigations of any possible breaches of the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement Bill 2005* between 10 March 2005 and 6 September 2005:

- (a) What was the value of the resources used in such investigations?
- (b) How many investigations were undertaken? .
- (c) What is the breakdown of investigations on a state-by-state basis?

Answer:

- (a) The value of resources used is approximately \$1800.
- (b) The Taskforce has initiated one formal investigation into possible breaches of the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement Bill 2005* between 10 March 2005 and 6 September 2005.
- (c) The investigation is in Western Australia.
