Fee-paying Australian Students

Data for fee-paying Australian students (undergraduate and postgraduate) in 2005 is at Attachment A.

Data for 2005 is not comparable with data for previous years. It includes a number of new private providers approved under the *Higher Education Support Act 2003* which commenced providing data from 2005. The 2005 data also includes students in enabling courses (who, since 2005 may be eligible for FEE-HELP), higher degree by research students for whom the tuition fee has been waived, and students who were previously enrolled in a Research Training Scheme place and have exceeded the time limit for that place. These students were not included in the answer to E671-06.

Private providers were required to submit data on fee-paying students who accessed Commonwealth assistance through FEE-HELP. Some private providers submitted more than the minimum required data.
