#### **Question:**

Senator Wong asked in writing: <u>Personal Support Programme – COAG Mental Health Places</u>. How many PSP participants are expected to use the COAG funded places in the five years for which they have been budgeted – given that one 'place' can be used on multiple occasions by PSP participants passing through the programme?

#### **Answer:**

As part of the COAG Mental Health package in the 2006-07 Budget, it was announced that 2,500 additional Personal Support Programme (PSP) places would be made available.

On average 1.3 participants flow through existing PSP places every two years.
