Question

Trade Training Centres in Schools Program

Senator CASH—That is in relation to the traditional trade skills. Can I also please obtain, in addition to these skills, the other top five areas of training that will be taught?

Mr De Silva—Including or excluding traditional trades there? Under the program you are eligible to apply for qualifications that lead to a traditional trade. There are also qualifications for emerging industries and there is also a narrow number of qualifications relating to agriculture and horticulture.

Senator CASH—Could I get both?

Round One (Phase One):

In Round One (Phase One) the top five Certificate III qualifications funded in traditional trades are as follows:

1. Certificate III in Carpentry
2. Certificate III in Hospitality (Commercial Cookery)
3. Certificate III in Bricklaying/Block-laying
4. Certificate III in Automotive Mechanical Technology
5. Certificate III in Engineering (Mechanical Trade)

In Round One (Phase One) only three Certificate III qualifications were funded in emerging industries:

1. Certificate III in Electrotechnology
2. Certificate III in Laboratory Skills
3. Certificate III in ESI Generation

In Round One (Phase One) the other top five Certificate III qualifications funded included the following:

1. Certificate III in Agriculture
2. Certificate III in Rural Operations
3. Certificate III in Horticulture
4. Certificate III in Production Horticulture
5. Certificate III in Horticulture (Arboriculture)

Round One (Phase Two)
