## Question

Cost of ballot

Is there a document that sets out what the factors are that you would be able to cost a ballot against?

## **Answer**

The Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) have advised the Department they have developed a costing and pricing template for Protected Action Ballots which sets out the processes to be followed for determining costs. Costs are charged for the following items:

- labour ongoing, non-ongoing and temporary staff hours;
- overheads;
- travel;
- ballot papers;
- envelopes; and
- printing.
