## BER FUNDING FOR SCHOOLS FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITY (SPECIAL SCHOOLS)

Is it correct that the main criterion for the allocation of BER funds to schools was based on student numbers? i.e. the more enrolled students, the more funding the school received?

## **Answer**

Yes. Funding allocations to each state, territory and Block Grant Authoritieswere calculated on the basis of the number of full-time equivalent enrolments (FTE) from the census data collected by the Department as of February 2009.

For the largest component of the BER program, Primary Schools for the 21st Century (P21), funding was provided on the basis of a primary school's total FTE student enrolments as determined by the February census data collection. For a K-12 school, only primary school FTE was counted. For a special school, both the number of FTE enrolments from the primary and secondary schools components were counted to calculate the indicative funding cap.
