## **RELOCATION OF JOB SEEKERS**

Senator ABETZ—..... In the last estimates, Ms Paul, without verballing you, I understand you claimed that the relocation of job seekers from the eastern states to the west had not been a success last time it was trialled by the department. Is that correct? Ms Paul—Yes. It was quite a long discussion, as I remember, and I think I said that there were many issues with the previous scheme which we would seek to change with any future scheme. Senator ABETZ—Our evaluation found that it was not a cost efficient or successful way of trying to support mobility. Ms Paul—That is right. Senator ABETZ—It is on page 48 from Monday, 31 May. Can I ask whether any advice was sought or provided prior to the calling of the election for the government about relocation of job seeker funds for such mobility? Ms Paul—I will probably take on notice whether we provided advice prior to the election. I know that in the past we would have provided advice arising from evaluation, but whether we provided advice before the election campaign I will need to take on notice.
