**Australian Youth Forum - Travel**

"How much was spent on travel for all activities associated with the Australian Youth Forum in 2010-11? How much was spent on: a) International economy class airfares? b) International business class airfares? c) International first class airfares? d) Domestic business class airfares? e) Domestic economy class airfares? f) Taxi fares? g) Public transport fares? "

**Answer**

A total of \$43,870 was spent on travel for Australian Youth Forum activities during the 2010-11 financial year. Listed below is a breakdown of travel types.

- a) international economy class airfares - nil
- b) international business class airfares – nil
- c) international first class airfares – nil
- d) domestic business class airfares – nil
- e) domestic economy class airfares – \$35,821
- f) taxi fares - \$7921
- g) public transport fares – \$128
