Job seeker compliance and new suspension provisions since 1 July 2011 - penalties

How many job seekers had a financial penalty imposed as a result of this measure? Provide details by job seekers' age, gender, payment type, Aboriginal/non-Aboriginal status, and vulnerability indicator

Answer

From the introduction of the new job seeker compliance arrangements on 1 July 2011 to 30 September 2011, 13 605 financial penalties were incurred by 12 546 job seekers for not attending reconnection appointments with their provider without having a reasonable excuse.
