### Question

### **Right of Entry Disputes**

How many disputes regarding right of entry have been bought before FWA in the last year? Were they take by unions or employers or others? How were they settled (conciliation, arbitration etc.)?

#### Answer

#### Fair Work Australia has provided the following response:

In the *2010/2011* reporting period, there were 40 applications to FWA to deal with a right of entry dispute. 30 applications were made by unions and 10 by employers. During that reporting period, of the 51 right of entry disputes finalised, 45 disputes were otherwise resolved, adjourned indefinitely or withdrawn, the remaining six were determined by arbitration. Arising from arbitration, the Tribunal issued orders in three matters but declined to issue orders in the other three.
