Parental capability building workshops

Mr Baker: I have not actually got the number of parent workshops that were run in the same location, Senator. So I would be careful to draw that assumption. Mr Davies: We could take that on notice, Senator. I just cannot recall whether they do parallel or whether there is a slightly different pattern.

Answer

The Australian Autism Education and Training Consortium is the current provider of Positive Partnerships. The consortium delivers professional development and parent/carer workshops in a range of metropolitan and rural/regional areas.

From November 2008 to October 2011 parent workshops were held in all but one of the Professional Development workshop locations.

A summary of the total number of parent/carer workshops held in regional and remote areas is detailed below:
