Answer

As at 30 September 2012, DEEWR had spent \$220,407.87 on 2013 Graduate Recruitment. This represents:

- \$206,183.57 on advertising, marketing and assessment (refer to table 1 for an itemised list of costs); and
- \$14,224.30 on travel expenses such as airfares, accommodation, taxis and incidentals for DEEWR employees (refer to table 2 for an itemised list of costs).
