I write to clarify evidence that I gave at the Senate Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade on 14 February 2007 the F-35 Joint Strike Fighter.

This information should read "Our very initial aircraft are about the fourth or fifth lot in the production line and the numbers gradually build up to approximately 15 a year **for Australia**."
