I am writing to clarify an aspect of evidence given by Mr John Buckley, First Assistant Secretary, International Security Division, to the Committee during the Supplementary Budget Estimates hearing on 6 November 2003.

Mr Buckley said, in paragraph 5 on page 48, that the department destroyed ONA documents in-house after those documents were read and returned to the area of the department responsible for their distribution. After further investigation of the issue, Mr Buckley has advised that the department destroys in-house certain categories of highly classified documents. The majority of intelligence documents, including ONA documents, are destroyed by one of the intelligence agencies on the department's behalf.
