Written Question on Notice

Senator Evans asked:

- 1. Can you please advise what matters have been referred to the AFP for investigation in the last twelve months?
- 2. Have those matters been concluded?
- 3. If so, what were the results?

Answer:

- 1. Since February 2006, the Australian Electoral Commission has referred four matters to the Australian Federal Police (AFP). They related to a possible internal fraud matter and possible contraventions of the enrolment, funding and disclosure, and bribery provisions of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918*.
- 2. Yes.
- 3. The AFP has advised that it would not investigate the matters further for reasons including a lack of evidence available that identifies a substantive Commonwealth offence, the likelihood of obtaining evidence that would lead to a successful prosecution, and competing operational priorities.
