- (3) What functions do recruitment agencies perform for departments and what would be likely impact on departmental outcomes from reduction in recruitment spending on external agencies?
- (4) What benefit-cost assessments have been done which benchmark internal recruitment processes and/or on utilising on line recruitment portals?

Answer: (1) what sum was spent on recruitment agencies in 2006

- □ \$120,209 (this amount also includes payment of wages for the temporary employment of staff and for scribing activities)

 - Adecco, Cantile Recuitment, Careers Unlimited, Effective People, Hays Personnel, Informed Sources, The One Umbrella, Greythorn P/L, TMP Worldwide.
- (3) What functions do recruitment agencies perform for departments and what would be the likely impact on departments outcomes from reduction in recruitment spending on external agencies
 - ☐ Functions undertaken by recruitment agencies were: identification and introduction of potential employees, mostly specialised staff ie. accountants, also the provision of temporary resources to fill internal staff storages and scribing duties associated with recruitment activities.
 - The impact on departmental outcomes: would in some instances result in hiring consultants to undertake agency activities, mostly at a cost far in excess of recruiting staff through recruitment agencies.
