Number of Pages: 1 Senator Barnett asked:

a) How many permanent employees were recruited since the supplementary budget estimates?

b) What level are these staff?

c) How many temporary positions exist or have been created since budget estimates?

d) Since supplementary budget estimates, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

a) 138 permanent (ongoing) employees were recruited between 20 October 2009 and 1 February 2010.

b) APS Level 1: 10 staff; APS Level 2: 1 staff; APS Level 3: 55 staff; APS Level 4: 9 staff; APS Level 5: 13 staff; APS Level 6: 10 staff; EL1: 19 staff; EL2: 16 staff; SES1: 5 staff.

c) 43 temporary (non-ongoing) employees (excluding casual COMCAR drivers) were engaged as at 26 May 2009. This level of non-ongoing employees remains stable.

d) 26 non-ongoing employees (i.e. employees employed on contract) have been recruited since 20 October 2009 with an average length of employment period of 5.3 months.
