Question:

a) Has the Department identified the status of election commitments within its purview?

b) Which of these commitments have yet to be completed? Why? What are revised expected completion dates for delayed commitments?

Answer:

- a) The Human Services portfolio has responsibility for the following 2007 Federal Election commitments:
- a new Medicare Australia office in Emerald, Queensland;
- additional Medicare Australia offices in Belmont, Western Australia and Belmont and Warrawong, New South Wales;
- winding up of the Office of Access Cards;
- · ceasing the Parliamentary Liaison Officer program;
- applying the one-off additional efficiency dividend of two per cent; and
- reversing additional funding for the Department of Human Services (DHS).
- b) DHS has met all of its 2007 Federal Election commitments.
