- 1. Does elevator technician Mr Darryl Potts have a Parliament House security pass?
- 2. Does he have access to other Government buildings?
- 3. If so, which buildings?
- 4. How often is Mr Potts at Parliament House? Is it his home base?
- 5. Is the Department aware that Mr Potts has been evaluated by a psychiatrist as a threat to public safety?
- 6. It has been revealed that Mr Potts has posted anti-Semitic and other offensive posts to various internet sites from Parliament House computers. Has any disciplinary action been taken against Mr Potts?
- 7. What is the current status of Mr Potts' employment with the Department of Parliamentary Services?

#### Answer

- 1 Mr Potts no longer has a Parliament House security pass.

- 4 Mr Potts worked at Parliament House on a daily basis and, while he worked here, it could be considered his usual place of work.

- 6 DPS has raised with Thyssen-Krupps Mr Potts' internet usage while working at Parliament House.
- 7 Mr Potts is not an employee of DPS. His employer, Thyssen-Krupps, has removed Mr Potts from site.
