Question:

Can you inform us as to what the storage capacity for data is on the BlackBerry devices.

Answer:

Of the three BlackBerry devices that have been authorised and provided to Senators and Members:

- the BlackBerry Bold 9000 RIM BlackBerry specifications data provides 128 MB ROM and 1GB built-in storage plus a storage expansion slot for unspecified size micro SD and micro SDHC cards;
- the BlackBerry Bold 9780 has 512 MB RAM with storage expansion micro SD/ micro SDHC up to 32 GB; and
- the BlackBerry Torch 9800 has 512 MB RAM / 512 MB ROM with built in storage of 4000 MB and a maximum capacity micro SD/ micro SDHC card of 32 GB.
