**Question: Senator MASON:** I will come back to you, Mr Sedgwick. But, before I forget: can the committee be provided with full data on absenteeism for every department and agency you have surveyed? I do not think that is in the current report.

Mr Sedgwick: It is not in the report.

**Senator MASON:** Could the committee please have that?

Mr Sedgwick: I will take that on notice. I do not know the basis of it.

**Senator MASON:** Yes, that is fine. Finally, if you could do what the minister has suggested and go behind those figures and inform the committee what you are doing to fight this problem, I would be delighted.

#### Answer:

Unscheduled absence data is provided to the Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) through the annual State of the Service agency survey in accordance with agreed definitions. Each agency (with 20 or more APS employees) provides the Commission with an average rate for the year based on its total unscheduled absence and average headcount/FTE.

Unscheduled absence rates for each reporting agency is attached. Total unscheduled absence, sick leave, carer's leave and other absence (including compensation and miscellaneous leave and unauthorised absence) are included. This data has been collected by the APSC since 2006–07 and the attachment includes each year's data.

The APSC has limited responsibility in this area. It is the responsibility of agencies to monitor and manage their employee absences. However the Commission does track median unscheduled absence rates through the State of the Service reports and identifies a range of strategies that agencies are using to manage absenteeism.

In most agencies, this is likely to have a marginal effect but caution should be exercised in comparing between agencies.

Total absence includes sick leave, carer's leave, compensation leave, miscellaneous leave and unauthorised absence.

Other absence includes compensation leave, miscellaneous leave and unauthorised absence.

'Not broken down' represents agencies' advice that their human resource system does not allow the agency to report unscheduled absence by the categories of sick leave, compensation leave, miscellaneous leave and unauthorised absence.
