Answer:

The department has estimated that average staffing levels will fall from levels as at 30 June 2011 due to a range of factors such as:

- the conclusion of the 2011 Commonwealth Heads of Governments Meeting;
- the establishment of the National Mental Health Commission during 2012; and
- the machinery of government changes announced on 14 December 2011.
