- 3. Is electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive) provided to department/agency staff? If yes provide details of what is provided, the purchase cost, the ongoing cost and a breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives it.
- 4. Does the department/agency provide their Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices with any electronic equipment? If yes, provide details of what is provided, the cost and to who it is provided.

Answer:

- 1. A Blackberry has an upfront cost of approximately \$700 (excluding GST).

Total ongoing costs for electronic equipment (such as iPad, laptop, wireless card, RSA token, blackberry, mobile phone) for the Department (excluding GST) for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013 (Administered and Departmental) were \$513,319.57.

Items such as thumb drives are purchased as stationery items and are not included in the above total. Expenditure for thumb drives is not itemised separately.

The Department does not record allocation of electronic equipment by staff classification. To attempt to provide this level of detail would involve an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.

4. Consistent with its role as the Minister's Portfolio Department responsible for meeting costs for computer equipment and additional equipment, the Department provides computer and other electronic equipment to the ministerial offices of the Prime Minister, the former Cabinet Secretary and the Parliamentary Secretary to the Prime Minister.
