The total cost for the period 1 December 2013 to 28 February 2014 is \$47,424 GST inclusive.

Services provided as part of the all-inclusive media monitoring total cost include:

- press clips
- broadcast clips
- transcripts
- media alerts.

With the transfer of Indigenous policies and programmes to the department, the department has agreed that Isentia Pty Ltd provide an Indigenous morning media report at a cost of \$5,000 per month. This commenced in mid-December 2013; costs since then are included in the amount of \$47,424.
