With reference to the document "The First 100 Days of Government" launched by the Prime Minister on 15 December 2013:

- 1. Why was the document not authorised under section 328 of the Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918?
- 2. Was the amount of \$11,247.35 met by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet the total sum of taxpayer funds expended in connection with the document?
- 3. Why were 370 copies of this taxpayer-funded document provided to the Office of the Prime Minister?
- 4. How were the 370 copies provided to the Office of the Prime Minister then distributed?
- 5. Were any copies of the document provided to the Liberal Party of Australia?
- 6. Why did the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet keep 45 copies of the document?
- 7. Who took the photographs published in the document?

Answer:

- 1. The document was not authorised under section 328 of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918* as it was not considered to be electoral matter.
- 2. Yes.
- 3. The Office of the Prime Minister requested copies.
- 4. The Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C) is not aware how the 370 copies were distributed.
- 5. No.
- 6. The 45 copies were distributed within PM&C.
