Ouestion:

- 1. How many ongoing staff recruited from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 2. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 3. From Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

ONA Response:

- 1. Six ongoing staff members have been recruited from 18 November 2013 to 28 February 2014. Their classifications are as follows:
 - a. 3 x ONA Band 3 (EL2)
 - b. 1 x ONA Band 1A (APS5/6)
 - c. 2 x ONA Band 1B (APS3/4)
- 2. Twelve non-ongoing staff members currently hold a position within ONA and their classifications are as follows:
 - a. 3 x ONA Band 3
 - b. 4 x ONA Band 1A (APS5/6)
 - c. 5 x ONA Band 1B (APS3/4)
- 3. As outlined in the *Office of National Assessments Act 1997*, employees engaged to perform the functions of the agency are employed under the *Public Service Act 1999* and not under contract. However, ONA does periodically engage specialists under labour hire contract arrangements.
